CIRCALENDAR - the round calendar

Circalendar is a round kalender, based on the understanding of time as being cyclic, like it is seen in several ancient wisdom traditions.

Circalendar refers more specifically to a wisdom tradition called the Delicate Lodge Teachings. It is directly inspired by this native american philosophy, where everything unfolds in cycles.

Throughout the year different energies are going on, and these are also connected to the four corners of the world.

A period of time that is emphasized is the winter time, called Kiva. On this calendar, the dark blue sector of the circle shows the length of the Kiva time through four moons from the 21rst of november to 21rst of march.


It is the dark, cold time when nature is asleep and the seeds of the new year are still lying in the ground, preparing for what will come. In this period it is also in the human nature to rest more, dream, become quiet and look inwards. To look back at the year passed, say goodbye and begin to dream the new seeds that will grow in the coming year.

The four Kiva Moons:

- 1: Look back on the year that passed and release.
- 2: Become **quiet**, reflect and be aware of what needs strengthening.
- 3: Make room for **new seeds**, let the dreams and inspiration come.
- 4: Plant new seeds so new ideas can grow.


When the Kiva period ends at Spring Equinox, it is the New Year of the tradition. March 20 this year. The equinoxes and solstices are the native american main festivals and are highlighted together with the four directions.
